Intern Agreement

I, _____, understand and agree to be counseled by a Graduate Intern in the Counseling and Psychology Program. I also understand that the intern will be receiving on-going supervision by a qualified supervisor at the school, as well as an on-site supervisor at The Northwest Catholic Counseling Center.

This intern position will end when the student graduates at which time counseling will be terminated or arrangements will be made to transfer you to another counselor. You will be notified of the date well in advance for planning and closure with the Intern.

The Northwest Catholic Counseling Center provides outpatient counseling only. Student interns do **not** provide psychological or forensic evaluation. They also cannot provide psychotherapy notes or other records for Social Security Disability, general assistance, Children and Family Services, and divorce and/or child custody or other legal issues, unless subpoenaed by a court of law. They cannot provide letters for an emotional support animal. If you or another clinician/clinic/agency requests your counseling records from our interns, those will be provided. You may also request confirmation of dates of treatment from our student interns.
